Voting by Mail



Picture

A busy parent sends their completed official election ballot through the mail, after receiving it from their election jurisdiction.

Example

A first time voter visits their designated polling place and submits a completed ballot in-person.

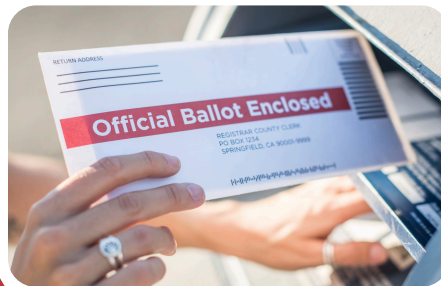
Definition

When voters request ballots from their local election office so that they can cast their votes without visiting their voting center on election day.

Picture

A college student attending school in a different state requests an absentee voting ballot from their home state's election office so they can participate in their local elections.

An office worker visits their local voting center on election day to vote in-person on their lunch break.

Definition

When an election jurisdiction automatically mails ballots to registered voters, without their needing to request them.

All-Mail Voting



Picture

California is an “all-mail voting” state. It automatically mails election ballots to every registered voter to provide the option of voting by mail.

Example

New York is not an all-mail voting state. Residents of New York who are registered voters must request an absentee ballot to vote in each election.

Definition

Mail that is created and distributed by political parties, campaign committees, and individuals. Political Campaign Mail promotes specific candidates and political issues.

Ms. Smith is running for town mayor. Her campaign staff create and send postcards that share Ms. Smith's stance on important issues to local business owners.
